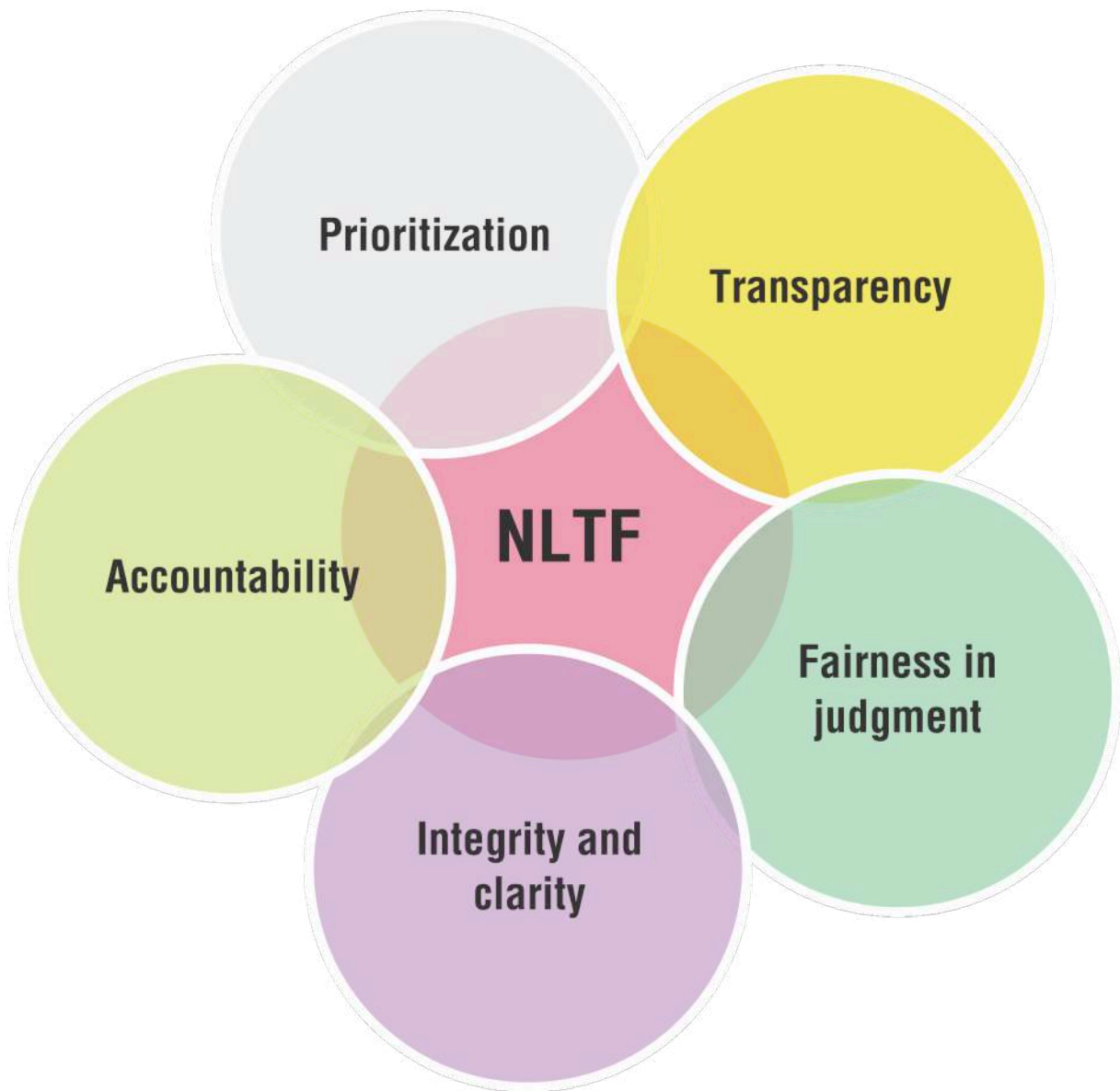

**We seek to:**

- a. Promote access to lottery funding given dwindling sources of public finance and deliver positive social outcomes (benefits) for those most in need through the promotion of good causes in our development work country-wide.
- b. Deliver our intervention programs in line with the aims set out in our strategic plan which focuses on the use of our resources (as approved by the President upon recommendation of our Board of Trustees), whilst retaining the flexibility to respond quickly and effectively to changing demands from applicants, potential applicants and grant recipients; and remain steadfast in intervening in projects prescribed by the extant law.





- c. Continue building awareness of the value of lottery to modern life and its transformational legacy, and foster understanding of the role of national lottery funding among Nigerians.
- d. Measure and evaluate the benefits lottery intervention funding has secured for Nigerians and encourage the protection of these legacies by beneficiaries.
- e. Investigate and develop industry-relevant grant-making policies and initiatives in response to external challenges and opportunities within our operating environment.
- f. Commence consultations with the general public and key stakeholders in the lottery industry.
- g. Make progress against service delivery targets as enshrined in the 'Servicom Charter' and reflect the Principles of Federal Character in our grant-giving practices, governance and the workforce.
- h. Continue to actively pursue the collections of statutory remittance of lottery proceeds from licensed lottery operators and product promoters in accordance with Section 24(3) of the extant law, and work actively in collaboration with the Ministry of Finance and

the National Lottery Regulatory Commission to grow the revenue profile of the Fund.



## What NLTF funds in Good Causes

The Trust Fund cannot expend funds on any good cause project, unless such project satisfies all the three conditions set out in section 40(a) of the Act.

The conditions are as follows: -

- a) The project should be in the interest of the Nigerian community, and fall within any of the under-listed sectors, among others,
  - i) The advancement, upliftment and promotion of sports development;
  - ii) The advancement, upliftment and promotion of Education;
  - iii) The advancement, upliftment and promotion of Social services;
  - iv) The advancement, upliftment and promotion of Public welfare and relief; and
  - v) The management of natural disasters in Nigeria.



## MANDATE OF THE AGENCY

**T**he National Lottery Trust Fund (“NLTF” or the “Trust Fund”) is an intervention agency of the Federal Government established under section 35 of the National Lottery Act 2005, to take custody of a percentage of the proceeds of all national lottery operations in Nigeria and utilize same in the execution of good cause projects across the country for the benefit of the Nigerian people.

### TARGETED INTERVENTION PROGRAMMES

Targeted intervention is to generate comprehensive needs assessment of areas lacking in basic amenities and other critical social infrastructure that guarantees minimum quality of life for the citizenry to benefit from good cause projects as provided under **Section 40(a) of the National Lottery Act, 2005.**

#### Areas of Intervention

Education intervention programmes are designed to reflect the deplorable condition of education infrastructure in the country, hence the enormous need for revitalization and revamping of the current poor status to one that would promote access to excellent physical



facilities and learning resources, and marched adequately with good and well-trained teachers.

Health, Social Intervention, Disaster Management, Environment, Vulnerable Group Interventions are critical in the provision of access to portable drinking water in our communities. Research and medical evidence suggest that high percentage of communicable diseases such as cholera, diarrhoea, dysentery, etc in our rural communities stem from unclean drinking water and poor sanitation. Most often, deaths arise from these preventable diseases as a result of lack of access to portable water and proper hygiene. Needs assessment pertaining to provision of solar powered bore-holes, sanitation materials and minimal water supplies reticulations.

Intervention in the health sector through the building, renovation and or equipping healthcare centres is evident by the agency's need to provide Nigerians with accessible and affordable high-tech medical service in order to curb mortality rate and medical tourism.

The growing rate of Internally Displaced Persons across the North-West, North-East and North-Central due to the activities of armed bandits and Insurgencies rendering thousands of Nigerians incapacitated and in dire need of some basic means of livelihood

through intervention/support in order to add visible value to their lives and help to improve their general wellbeing, hence the need to provide relief/management of natural disaster has recently becomes a priority area of needs across the country.

#### **a. PROJECT SELECTION CRITERIA**

Providing intervention in line with section 40 (a) of the lottery act is the core mandate of the trust fund, but due to hitherto lack of public awareness about the trust fund, most people view accessing intervention grant/project as a big huddle. As a policy, Intervention project proposals selected for funding generally must incorporate the following criteria.

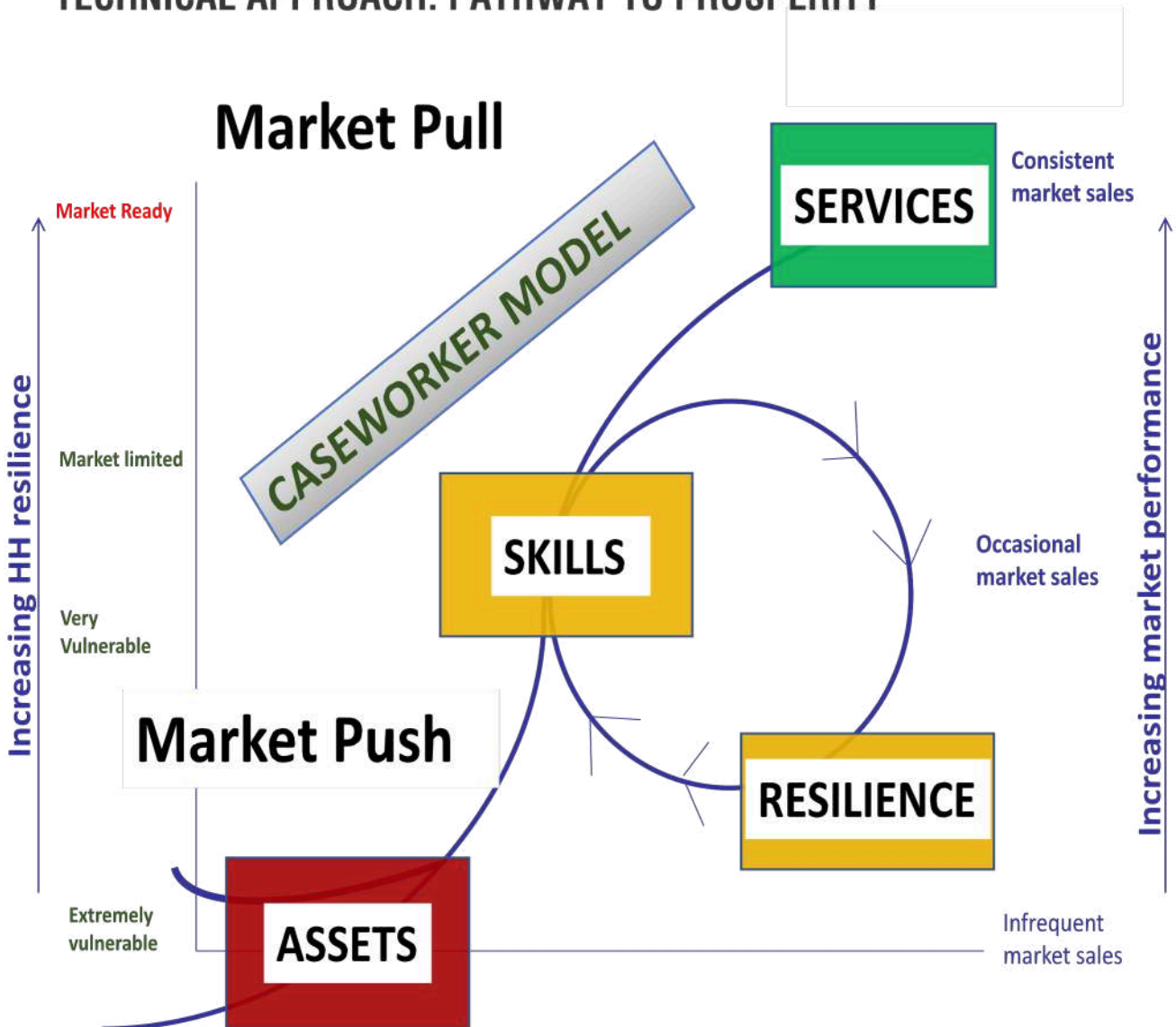
- I. Respond initiatives and aspiration of the local community
- II. Involve a significant local contribution in cash, labour or material
- III. Improve basic economic or social conditions in the community,
- IV. Benefit a large group of people through high impact, quickly implementable activities,
- V. Be completed within 12 months and should not require additional funds for maintenance, and
- VI. Have visible benefits for the community and self-sustaining

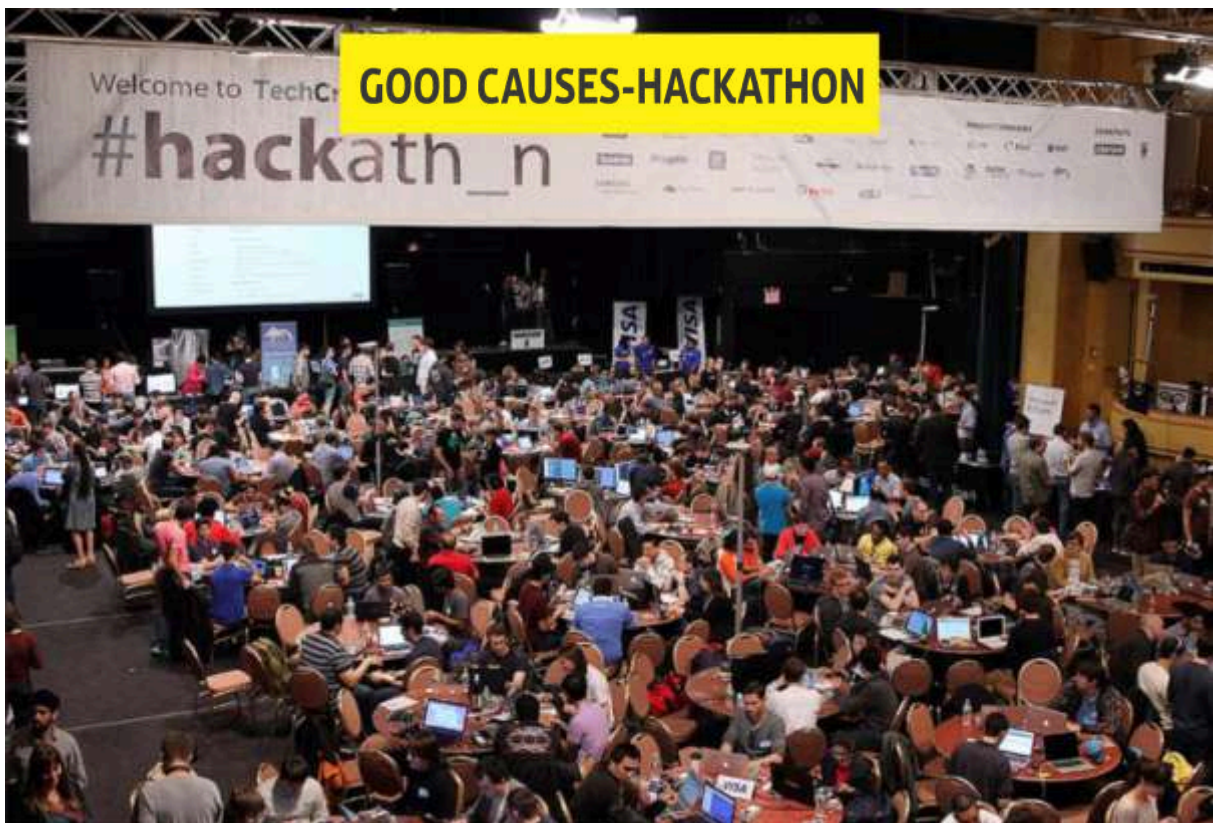

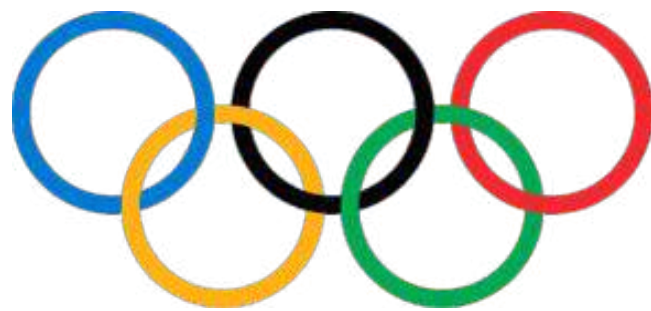
